

Alumni Scholarship Program

This scholarship program is designed to provide tuition assistance for furthering the education of graduates from a program of any StrataTech Education Group school. The criterion outlined below has been designed to give the Scholarship Awarding Committee maximum flexibility in awarding the scholarship. Recipients will be selected without regard to race, sex, color, creed, religious preference, age, national origin, or disability.

Eligibility Criteria:

To be awarded the scholarship, students must:

- Be a graduate from any program at any of the StrataTech Education Group schools;
- be enrolled in an eligible* program at any of the StrataTech Education Group schools;
- complete an Alumni Scholarship Request Form;
- have no lapse in proper registration; and
- maintain all aspects of Satisfactory Academic Progress.

Award Process and Rules

- All programs are eligible for this scholarship, unless the enrollee is a graduate of the Professional Welder (PW) or Welding Specialist (WS) program and is enrolled for Professional Welder with Pipefitting (PWP), or Welding Specialist with Pipefitting (WSP).
- Each student must complete an Alumni Scholarship Request Form.
- Scholarships are not transferable or renewable and cannot be used in conjunction with any other institutional scholarship.
- Only one award will be given per student. If a student is eligible for multiple scholarships, the scholarship that is most beneficial to the student will be awarded.
- Maximum scholarship amount will not exceed \$1,500.
- Scholarships will be distributed incrementally over the entire length of the student's academic program.
- Scholarships are based on the enrolled student's start date. If a student changes their start date, the scholarship award may be forfeited.
- Scholarship eligibility requires continuous enrollment. Termination from training may result in the loss of this scholarship.
- Scholarships may be limited and will be awarded on a first come, first-served basis.
- Students must maintain all aspects of Satisfactory Academic Progress.

Our Policy

Any student meeting the scholarship criteria may apply. Only one scholarship may be awarded per student. This scholarship is not transferrable. It will be applied incrementally to the student's account over the entire length of the student's academic program. The maximum award is \$1,500.

Students must complete this request form and submit it with their letter of recommendation to the Scholarship Selection Committee to be considered. Of the requests received, each will be reviewed for completeness and accuracy of all information provided. Of those eligible requests, the awards will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis.

This scholarship program is based on the enrolled student's start date. There may be a limited number of scholarships to be awarded. Only one scholarship may be awarded per student. If a student changes his start date, his/her scholarship award may be forfeited.
